

ECCS Logic and Rhetoric School Student Supply List 2016-2017

All students in grades 6-12 should bring the following supplies:

- Pencils/Pens (black and red)
- Highlighters (4 color)
- Loose leaf paper, college ruled
- Expo markers (for individual white boards) and something to use to erase
- Index tab dividers if ring binders are on your list
- Pocket folder (no brads necessary) for handouts in math
- Graph paper for math and physics (4 squares per inch)
- NASB Bible will be supplied in classrooms. You will need access to NASB translation at home (www.biblegateway.com is a great free source)

All students in Grades 10-12 students are required to have a laptop with Microsoft Word installed. Logic School students may not bring laptops to school.

Sixth Grade:

Seventh Grade:

- Index cards (any size, any color - 200 count) for Latin (or another method for studying vocabulary)
- ½” binder with pockets for Bible
- 1” 3-ring binder for Latin and Life Science
- 1” 3-ring binder for Math
- Non-scientific calculator for Math
- 1” 3-ring binder for History
- Colored pencils for History
- Pocket folder and post it notes for Literature
- 2-pocket folder w/o brads for Grammar
- 1 composition notebook (not spiral bound) for Literature

Eighth Grade:

- Index cards (any size, any color-200 count) for Latin (or another method for studying vocabulary)
- 1” 3-ring binder for Latin (or other method for taking notes and keeping handouts)
- Algebra 1 notebook (one subject will suffice, but will need 4-6 for the year)
- 3 hole punched, 1 subject spiral notebook for Literature
- Sticky tabs, post it notes for History
- 1” 3-ring binder with folder pockets for Bible
- 1” 3-ring binder with folder pockets Literature
- Pocket folder for Science
- 4x6 Index cards (lined), 2” ring binder, and page protectors for Logic and History Debate Project (won’t need until project starts)
- 2-pocket folder with brads for handouts in Logic
- Calculator for Algebra I: TI 30X series (preferably TI 30XSmultiview)

Ninth Grade:

- 2-pocket folder with brads and composition book in Logic
- Composition book for Logic
- 200 index cards (any size, any color) for History
- Method to study vocabulary (such as index cards) for Latin
- Composition notebook (not spiral bound) pocket folder and post it notes for Literature
- Method to take and keep notes in Biology, Latin, History, Literature, Bible, Geometry – student choice
- Index cards, 2” ring binder, and page protectors for Logic and History Debate Project (won’t need until project starts)
- TI30X series (preferably TI30XSmultiview) or TI83 or TI84 graphing calculator (TI83 or TI84 required in Algebra II)
- MLA Handbook (most recent)
- Composition notebook for Bible

Tenth Grade:

- 2-pocket folder with brads for handouts in Rhetoric
- Method to take and keep notes in Chemistry, Latin, History, Literature, Bible, Math –student choice
- TI30X series (preferably TI30XSmultiview) or TI83 or TI84 graphing calculator (TI83 or TI84 required in Algebra II)
- 2-pocket folder with no brads for Bible and History
- 4 colored index cards for Chemistry (100)
- MLA Handbook (most recent)
- Index cards, 2” ring binder, sheet protectors, tab dividers for Rhetoric and Literature research essay project.

- TI83 or TI84 graphing calculator
- MLA Handbook (most recent)
- 2” pocket folder with brads and composition book for Rhetoric II
- Index cards, 2” ring binder, sheet protectors, tab dividers for organizing thesis material
- Remember to bring your Commonplace book. New students will be provided a Commonplace book.

Twelfth Grade
